

26 PUC is a letter dated 19.4.2018 received from the following Research Scholars attached with Prof. (Dr) Anvita Abbi, Padmashree, who has been deputed by the Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysore to carry out the documentation work on two endangered languages of the Car Nicobar islands namely Sanenyo spoken in Chowra Island and Lura spoken in Teressa Island.

28 Considering their expertise in the field of linguistics, it has been decided that they will be assigned with the task to carry out the documentation of Jarawa language under the supervision of AAJVS. In the first instant, the above named research scholars will conduct a pilot survey of the Jarawa reserve in order to gather information about the terrain and the people so that they can have a better understanding to document the same in the forthcoming field visit

28 As per Section 7 of the PAT, 1956, the Dy Commissioner is the competent authority to grant necessary permission to enter in the reserved area. It is proposed that we may convey no objection to the Assistant Commissioner (HQ), South Andaman District to carry out the research on the following terms and conditions:-

1. Study should be carried out under the overall supervision of Executive Secretary, AAJVS
2. The following persons (i) Shri Rahul Pachori (ii) Ms Rakhi Kumari (iii) Ms Suyashi and (iv) Ms Vyaskh are only being permitted to enter in the Jarawa Tribal Reserve area for study.
3. The team should be escorted with AAJVS officials and Police Personnel.
4. The team should complete research work before 2:00 PM and shall leave the Jarawa Reserve Area by availing last convoy.
5. They should deposit the mobile phone, or any camera with the Police Outpost, Jirkatang. No photography shall be allowed in the Jarawa Reserve Area. The team should ensure that no cigarette, alcohol, match box, lighter or any other inflammable articles shall be carried in the Jarawa Reserve Area
6. The outcome of the study should be shared with the AAJVS.
7. No undue interference in the lives of Jarawa tribes during the course of research work
8. Necessary statutory permits for entry into tribal reserve should be obtained from the District Administration.
