The Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests (IA Division), New Delhi vide the above said letter has stated that the project has been considered and discussed in the 63<sup>rd</sup> Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry) meeting held during 28<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> March'2007, during the discussion the Committee desired to submit certain information which includes "Permission from the Ministry of Tribal Affairs for setting up of Industry".

In this context, it is stated that as per the A & N (PAT) Regulation, 1956, the area of Burmanallah, Kodiaghat, South Andaman is not a tribal reserved area.
