In this context it may be stated that Prof. Anvita Abbi of JNU and her team of research scholars have already been permitted to carry out linguistic research on the Great Andamanese of Strait Island vide this office letter No.1-272/2003-TW (PF)/1041 dated 14/7/04 at pages 9-10/cor with the approval of Chief Secretary, A & N Administration. In the wake of the above permission the Research team of JNU had earlier conducted the linguistic research on Great Andamanese in July'04 and March'05. As the project is yet to complete, they have asked for tribal pass for stay on Strait Island for another six months so as to work for completion of the project.
