PUC is the letter No.5-5/LS/2006/2964 dated 31st May 2006 from Assistant Commissioner (HQ), DC Office, Port Blair regarding Tribal Pass. They have forwarded the application for the Tribal Pass filled with them by Shri G. Narisimhan Student of Madras Christian College who is intending to visits Car Nicobar for Academic research on the Topic 'A Study on the development of the Nicobar Tribals'.

Perusal of the documents forwarded by DC office, Port Blair reveals that Madras Christian College is an autonomous organization. It is not clear as to which University the said college is affiliated to. The credential and antecedents of the applicant are not known.

However, the Topic of the study proposed to be conducted by applicant appears to be useful for the Government. If he is permitted to visit Car Nicobar and study, he could be asked to submit a copy of his report to the Deputy Commissioner (Nicobar) and Deputy Commissioner (Andaman) as one of the conditions of the Tribal Pass among others.

As per the A & N Islands (PAT) Regulation 1956, the Deputy Commissioner of the District is the statuary authority to consider the application for Tribal Pass.
