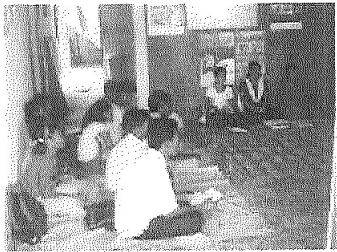
**Exhibition:**

**Life skill education:**

Life Skills Education sessions (LSES) is being adopted as a means to empower young people and children in challenging situations. It is an interactive process of teaching and learning which enables learners to acquire knowledge and to develop attitudes and skills which support the adoption of healthy behaviours. Education should not be fixed in content; it should be flexible, adaptable, involving examples of learning. LSE sessions were conducted for adolescent children (13-18 years) in CDCs.
