details of on going research works also and decide about the need to pursue these research works. In case Research work has been completed the finding should be placed before the Standing Committee for analysis. All these details should be submitted before the Executive Council alongwith the view / recommendations of the Standing Committee in its next meeting.

14 But these research students have done extensive works of the Great Andamanese language in last year, has not submitted their papers so far either to Directorate of Tribal Welfare or AAJVS.

15 Moreover, the communication received from the Joint Secretary, Ministry of Tribal affairs with a direction that other Primitive Tribal Groups should be left in there own and unnecessary interference in their life in the name of studying these tribals should not be encouraged. Further Ministry requested us to ensure that such undue interferences in the lives of the Primitive Tribal Groups do not take place without the approval of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. 16 It is therefore, proposed that we may ask the students to submit what ever works they have done on the Great Andamanese Language in last year for placing before the Standing Committee for analyze and decision the Executive Council of AAJVS and the decision and the recommendation of the Executive Council we may communicate this students accordingly.
