



## **General Information**

The Institute will be a major point for coordinating and clearing for world-class research and study related to the Island's tribal communities. Some degree of funding may be considered from time to time depending on the quality of application and relevance to the particular concerns of the institute.

Within this wide range of research areas, applications in the Special emphasis categories of 'Indigenous Well-Being', 'Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Intellectual Property' and 'Strengthening Community' would be particularly invited for the Research Grants Program.

ANTRI particularly seeks proposal broadly dealing with systems of knowledge, culture of language, and ethno history schooling system, communicating rights, awareness and obligations at various levels. Please see the mission statement of ANTRI to craft appropriate research question.

Proposal dealing with producing creative forms of products based on research findings, such as films, sound recordings, and documentations may be also considered but not essentially funded. We would encourage specialized data repository forms and processes that could be created to hold the documents and images (digitally) for policy implementation and welfare.

Sponsored research that solely provides an academic degree to the applicant will not be considered, exceptions may be made for PhD. Student registered in reputed university.

Research leading to an academic degree may be considered and supported, but will not be funded.

How to Apply

Applicants for the ANTRI research program of any kind have to submit the following:

- 1. CV with contact details (email ID mandatory)
- 2. Research proposal:
- 3. Brief abstract in non-technical language.
- 4. Background to the research question raised,
- 5. A brief review of related literature
- 5. Why your research work must be carried out among the Andaman Nicobarese tribal's.
- 6. What is the relevance of the proposed research project to people of the island?
- 7. What is the relevance of the proposed research at large.
- 8. Name and contact (@mail) of three references that will be sent for you.
- 9. Writing sample of at least 5000 words (published or unpublished)
