Sir,

As requested, I am directed to convey the permission of Chief Wildlife Warden, Andaman & Nicobar Islands to undertake "the DBT Project on Mapping of Plant Resources of Andaman & Nicobar Islands" in Protected Areas for a further period of 15 months from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2014 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2015 under section 28 (1) (c) read with 35 (8) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 with permission for entry into the Protected Areas for the team members listed in your application.

This permission is subject to the following conditions:

1. Necessary entry permit should be obtained from concerned Deputy Conservator of Forests/Divisional Forest Officer's after paying necessary entry fee during each visit to the Protected Areas.
2. Use of plastic bags & littering of bottles inside Protected Areas are banned.
3. There should not be any littering and the garbage's if any, should be brought back.
4. There should not be any cooking or kindling of fire inside the Protected Areas.
5. No person shall carry any weapon, ammunitions, explosive, chemicals etc which may cause injury or endanger any wildlife in the Protected Areas.
6. Collection of samples of plant parts shall be only for the purpose of making herbarium and the same be obtained without causing damage to the plant.
7. After completion of the survey, a report should be submitted to this office.
8. This permit is liable for cancellation in the event of violation of any provision of the Act/permit.
9. They should obtain the tribal area entry permits from the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman/Nicobar District for entering the tribal Reserve Area at South Andaman island, Middle Andaman island and Nicobar District.
