

PUC is a letter dated 20.7.2015 received from the Dy Resident Commissioner, Kolkata, wherein, it has been informed that the National Atlas & Thematic Mapping Organization, Govt of India, Kolkata has deputed Ms Sweta Banerjee, Research Associate to Port Blair to conduct research on Socio Economic status of Settlers and tribes from 15<sup>th</sup> August to 24 August, 2015. During her stay, the Research Associate shall hold discussions with the Director (Tribal Welfare) and the Associate Town & Country Planner at Port Blair. She will be accompanied by her family (4 members). During the course of research, she shall visit Rangat, Mayabunder, Diglipur, Neil & Havelock islands. The DRC, Kolkata has requested to make a tentative tour programme alongwith accommodation to visit all places. Payment for accommodation and transport shall be borne by Ms Sweta Banerjee, Research Associate, itself.

In this connection, it is proposed that we may request the Protocol Officer, A&N Administration to book 2 rooms in the Circuit House, South Point or Haddo and provide the vehicle. In view of the above request, following are programme suggested, if the competent authority agrees.

 Proposed Itinerary of Ms Sweta Banerjee, Research Associate to Port Blair from 15.8.2015 to 24.8.2015. We may categorically inform the Research Associate that during the course of research at A&N Islands, interaction with tribals will not be allowed to her.
