(VI) Gender issues among Jarawas:

(13) It was informed that a Workshop on gender issues had already been organized at ANTRI and one more such workshop was needed for sensitizing the settlers and the Jarawas of their duties and responsibilities for welfare of both the communities. However, in view of the recent incidence in Tirur and ATR and the discussions held at Raj Niwas in the recent past, the Secretary (TW) asked Executive Secretary, AAJVS to organize a workshop at Tirur area by calling the Superintendent of Police (SA), DFO(SA), Officials of ANTRI, AAJVS and the PRI Members to educate them about the provisions made in PAT Regulation, 1956 and Do's & Don'ts so that people of both the communities are made aware of their duties and responsibilities for maintaining public order in the area. He further asked that one such interactive meeting be immediately organized till Prof. Pandya prepares a detailed proposal to this effect.

(VII) Road Traffic on ATR in Middle Andaman Island:

(14) On the issue of movement of traffic after the sunset on the ATR abutting on to Jarawa Reserved area in the Middle Andaman Island, Secretary (TW) informed that the matter would be discussed with the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration before taking any view on the matter.

(VIII) Base Camp at 16 Km point on East - West Road, GNI:

(15) As regards the need for having a Base Camp at 16 KM Point, it was decided that the Tribal Welfare Officer, Campbell Bay shall tie up with APWD Campbell Bay for submitting the estimates for construction of base camp with RCC stilt in consultation with DFO (ND), Campbell Bay as also for the maintenance of the jungle road up to 16 Km Point on the East West Road so that the facility could be used by the Shompens as well as patrolling party. ES AAJVS shall pursue the matter and put up estimates in file for approval.

(IX) Staff for the ANTRI:

(16) Being administrative matter it was decided that the issue be dealt administratively.

(X) Coconut Plantation for Onges of Little Andaman:

(17) After detailed discussion, it was decided that ES, AAJVS shall examine the matter in detail and put up the case for consideration of the competent authority of the Administration.
