- (18) Prof. Pandya informed that Shri Nikhil Pandhi, Rhodes Scholer (2014), M Phil Candidate in Archaeology, Jesus College, University of Oxford U.K. had expressed his intention to contribute for development of Museum of ANTRI and other research matters related to PVTGs. However, he informed that the exact topic of research/work could be discussed in due course.
- (19) After detailed discussion, it was decided that Prof. Pandya may go through the research proposal and suggest as to how the expertise of the scholar could be utilized for the benefit of ANTRI/Administration.

(XII) De-addiction of Andamanese in Strait Island:

(20) As the de-addiction of Andamanese in Strait Island, is an urgent and important matter it was decided that the Deputy Director Tribal Health Directorate of Health Services and AAJVS shall organize de-addiction camp immediately for counseling the persons addicted to alcoholism and other psychotropic substances.

(XIII) New ANTRI Complex at Shore Point near Bambooflat:

(21) As regards of the land proposed to be allotted at Shore Point, it was decided that the action as decided in the meeting held on 02.03.2015 and 17.04.2015 may be taken by Director (TW), Director (ANTRI) and Executive Engineer RCD APWD Wimberlygunj.
