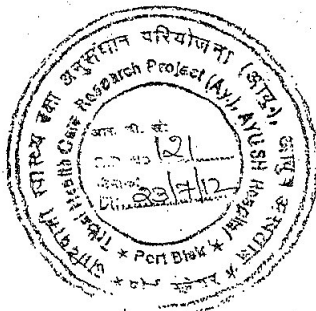

OFFICE ORDER NO. 1182/2012-13

On recommendation of CCRAS-IMR PEMC, sanction of the Director General, CCRAS is hereby conveyed to the payment of Rs. 45, 61, 000/- (Rupees forty five lakh sixty one thousand only) to Research Officer Incharge, ATHCRP, Port Blair for meeting the expenditure on Project entitled "Medico-Botanical Survey of Andaman & Nicobar Islands (selected areas) under CCRAS- Intra Mural Research Projects in Ayurvedic Sciences". The approval of competent authority is also conveyed to the release of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment comprising of 60% of total budget i.e. Rs. 27, 36, 600/- (Rupees twenty seven lakh thirty six thousand six hundred only) as Contingent Advance as per the projected budget with the following terms & conditions;

1. The Institute will submit the Quarterly progress report as per format after starting the survey, the first day of the subsequent month.
2. The advance for the project subject to further conditions and principles laid down in Rule 148 to 151 of the General Financial Rules 1963.
3. You are requested to maintain separate record of the expenditure for Audit purpose.
4. After first year project, the Utilization Certificate, expenditure statement duly audited by the authorised Auditor/Chartered Accountant along with unspent balance, if any may please be sent to Council for release of second year instalment.
5. The Council reserves the full right to issue guidelines during the course of the studies.
6. The observations derived from these studies and carried out under the project will not be communicated to any other party without Council's permission.
7. No. research paper/any other communication will be published out of these studies.
8. Fund will be released on phased manner by the Council as per the progress of study within the approved budgetary provision.
9. The manpower sanctioned for assistance under this project will not in any way be the responsibility of the Council for further absorption. The service of manpower may be terminated immediately after completion of project.
10. The staff can be employed on contract basis. None of these will be in any manner be employee of CCRAS. The project Head is responsible for selection, appointment and supervision of the staff.
11. The tenure of the project will be for 03 (Three) years.
12. All the terms & Conditions laid down in CCRAS- IMR rules should be followed.
