Sir,

I am directed to enclose herewith a letter received from Shri Manish Chandi, Field Director, ANET, Principal Investigator regarding issue of tribal pass.


In this context, it is stated that DST, GoI and WWF has initiated a multi-locational coordinated programme titled "People and Projected Areas (PAs): Conservation and Sustainable Livelihoods in Partnership with Local Communities." The project has been launched in August'2014 in partnership with 16 NGOs and CBOs. These organizations will work with different tribal communities living within and around Projected Areas (PAs) from diverse ecosystems for a period of 3 years to address the issues of their livelihood and conservation. About 75 villages/hamlets will be covered with around 6000 households under this project.

Shri Manish Chandi, Field Director, ANET, Principal Investigator has been entrusted to execute the project. This Administration has been requested to extend support to the field level project implementing team.


Therefore, this Directorate recommends for the issue of tribal pass to Shri Manish Chandi, Field Director, ANET, Principal Investigator for visiting Southern Nicobar Islands with the condition that he may not intervene with the life style and culture of the tribals which may categorically be incorporated in the tribal pass.
