Chapter III- Licence for trade or business

Rule 8 Grant of Licence – On an application filed under 7, if the Chief Commissioner, after such enquiry as he may deem fit to make, does not reject the application, he may, subject to the provisions of these rules, grant a licence for a period of not exceeding one year

Chapter IV- Miscellaneous

The above said Rules containing Chapter II, III 7 IV was amended in the year 1960, with the following substitutions/definitions

- 2 (c) "General trade or business" means the trade or business covered by the licence in From-F
- (d) "Licence" means a licence granted in Form F or in Form H by the Chief Commissioner under Sub-Section (1) of Section 6 to carry on in any reserved area general trade or business, or miscellaneous trade, as the case may be
- (e) "license" means a person, or a body of individuals including a member or members of an aboriginal tribe, to whom a licence has been granted
- (g) "Misc Trade" means the following: -
- 1. Works relating to PWD and IAF contracts
- 2. Stevedoring
- 3. Sale of timber

4. Import and Export trade and

5. Such other trade as may from time to time be specified by the Chief Commissioner

Tribal Pass is an important mechanism by which influx of non-tribal in reserve area be regulated. There are provisions for further renewal of tribal pass by the Dy Commission & Assistant Commissioner office concerned based on the report of local police station about his character and antecedents for the time spent in tribal area.

In light of the above, it is clarified that the tribal pass can only be issued to a person, or a body of individuals, as provided in the Regulations, as stated above.
