4. The team should complete laying work before 2:00 PM and shall leave the Jarawa Reserve Area by availing last convoy.
5. They should deposit the mobile phone, or any camera with the Police Outpost, Jirkatang. No photography shall be allowed in the Jarawa Reserve Area. The team should ensure that no cigarette, alcohol, match box, lighter or any other inflammable articles shall be carried in the Jarawa Reserve Area
6. The outcome of the study should be shared with the ANTRI and APWD, so that it may help them to take appropriate actions to reduce landslide in that area
7. No undue interference in the lives of Jarawa tribes during the course of lying work
8. Necessary statutory permits for entry into tribal reserve should be obtained from the District Administration.

Subject to approval, a draft letter is placed alongside. The Secretary (TW) is the competent authority.
