There is no mention of specific diseases to ^{which} the P.T.Gs' are subjected. It has been reported that they are under nourished and under developed. To overcome the complications arising out of mal-nutrition and under nourishment, the children and lactating mothers as well as old and disabled persons are proposed to be supplied therapeutic food and medicines. ~~The~~ provision of Rs.6.28 lakhs has been made which is expected to benefit about 1250 families during 1992-97.
