Supply of quality medicines: The issue regarding supply of quality medicines and economy in purchase, the Director of Health Services informed that the medicines supplied in Andaman & Nicobar Islands are procured 50% from Medical Store Depot and 50% through Global Tenders, which are quality-wise much better compared to all other States and are purchased through competitive bidding. Hon'ble Member of Parliament stated that the purchase cost of medicines compared to Tamil Nadu Medical Corporation (TNMC) is much higher in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The Chief Secretary directed the Secretary (Health) to explore the possibilities of procuring quality medicines with utmost economy in the same line of the Tamil Nadu Medical Corporation procures.
